English

In English this term we will be learning about a variety of text types, including:

Discussion

Narrative

Persuasive Texts

Poetry

The expectation is that your child will read with an adult at least 3 times a week and this should be recorded in their reading diaries.

Our current class book is Secret of Platform 13 by Eva Ibbotson.

Maths

In Maths this year, we are going to be placing a strong focus on learning our times tables as it is expected that all children know up to 12 x 12 by the end of year 4. In order to do this, children will be taking part in fast maths throughout each week. Please support your child by helping them to learn their times tables and associated division facts at home on a regular basis.

Children will also complete weekly arithmetic tests to consolidate their basic skills.

Our Maths curriculum for the summer term includes:

Written calculations.

Time

Properties of numbers.

Calculating with money.

Interpreting Data

Properties of 2D shapes.

Area and perimeter.

History and Geography:

During Summer 1, our history focus is on Victorian Inventions.

In summer 2 our geography focus is Polar Regions.

Computing

In computing lessons this year, children will have the opportunity to develop new skills which they will be able to use in other curriculum areas. These will include algorithms and programming.

Science

This term our Science topic is Sound. We will be looking at many of the scientific processes that occur within each of these areas as well as how to design, conduct and evaluate a fair investigation.

The children's PE is on a Monday.

Homework

The children have their homework set on Purple Mash on a Thursday and it is to be completed by the following Tuesday. If you need your child's Purple Mash log on, please contact your child's class teacher.
