

REQUEST FROM JAYDEN JEREMY IN YEAR 5

On the 1st June 2019 I had to be admitted to hospital because I was really poorly. My appendix became infected and my stomach and bowels shut down and stopped working. I was in hospital for 24 days and had to have two major operations before I was allowed to come home. One of the things that really cheered me up whilst I was in hospital was when the staff, who worked so hard looking after all the children in hospital used to give us little gifts after surgery to try and cheer us up. All the gifts that are given to the children have been donated. I would like to donate some gifts to the hospital to try and make all the poorly children a little bit happier. I will be visiting the Royal Worcester Hospital Children's Ward on 30th November 2019 and I would love to be able to take some gifts for the children. Anything would be appreciated for children aged 0 –17 years old. It has to be new and can not be a cuddly toy because of the rules around infection control.

I would be really grateful if you could help me and put a smile on children's faces.
